Pershore Abbey Iona Service - Sunday 23rd June 2024 5pm A service of quiet reflection before the election

Welcome and Introduction: As the election draws nearer, this service provides an opportunity for quiet reflection and prayer away from the noise of media politics. We will have two periods of silence and stillness. Rather than focussing on God as beyond or above us, we turn our attention to God who dwells within each of us. Spending time with God in quiet is not an escape from the troubles of the world, for the God we encounter is also at the heart of the world's life and struggles.

Opening responses:

Leader: When the time was right, God sent the Son.

All: He came among us; he was one of us. (a cross is placed centrally)
